Dedication to Carl White



Carl White, 11/18/1923, moved to an old farmhouse on Union Street in Levant with his wife, Pat, in 1944 after serving in the Navy in WWII. He happily donated a parcel of land to build the Levant School in the Village and donated the hay from his fields to his dairy farm neighbors – the Bemis’s. Carl or “Whitey” raised two sons and two daughters who entertained countless neighbor friends. Always willing to help, he participated in Minerva Grange and the Levant Volunteer Fire Department. Carl is a Mason with the Kenduskeag Lodge #137. He still happily entertains his family and friends today across from the Bemis farm on his original plot of land.

It is with great pleasure that the Town of Levant recently presented Carl White with the Boston Post Cane. The presentation of the cane is a long-standing tradition in the Town where the most senior resident is recognized by taking possession of the cane.
